### Associate in Asto Bachelor of Arts in History

#### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in AART) at the Gateway Community and Technical CollegeCTC and leads to the Bachelor of Antes A) in History at Northern Kentucky University (NKU)

#### Applying to the Gateway2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Gateway CTC, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Gateway CTC.

#### Degree Requirements for GCTC

1) Completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural competencese, 5) demonstration of digital literacy, and 5) college success requirement.

#### Admission Requirements to NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

This major can be completed fatte-face or online. If completed

KCTCS Scholars Awaßtudents who are KY residents transferring directly from a KCTCS institution with at least 36 hours fromhat institution and minimum GPA of 3.0, were never enrolled as a degree seeking student at NKU, and will be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours both fall and spring semester are eligible for a limited number of \$2,500 annual scholarships (\$1,250 per fall and spring). Students must gain admission to NKU by June 15 for fand November 1 for spring to be eligible for a possible scholarship. Online accelerate to prams are not eligible for the KCTCS Scholars Award.
