

TRANSFERATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate in Artto Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associate in Art(AA) at Gateway Community and Technical College CTC and leads to the Bachelor of Art(BA) in Philosophy degree at Northern Kentucky Universit(NKU)

Applying to the Gatewa NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hourseway, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Gateway

Degree Requirements for Gateway

1) Completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural competencese, 5) demonstration of digital literacy, 6) college success requirement.

Admission Requirements to NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at. Note that the course students must meet prerequisites for all courses Students must have a minimum GPA20 for courses that count towards the major as well as an overall GPA of 2.0. Students must complete a focus or minor as indicated pathway.

General Transfer Information

Students must complete the online application to NKU. There is no applicate for students who are transferringfrom a KCTCS institution

KCTCS Scholars Awa&tudents who are KY residents transferring directly from a KCTCS institution with at least 36 hours from that institution and minimum GPA of 3.0, were never enrolled as a degree seeking student at NKU, and will be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours both fall and spring semester are eligible for a limited number of \$2,500 annual scholarships (\$1,250 per fall and spring). Students must gain admission to NKU by June 15fath and November 1 for spring to be eligible for a possible scholarship. Online accelerate to grams are not eligible for the KCTCS Scholars Award.
